Read - Pray - Reflect on these Scripture passages.

Jesus' Prayer for His Disciples - John 17:17,20

"Jesus said, 'Father, consecrate them in the truth... As you sent me into the world, so I send them into the world... I pray not only for them, but also for those who will believe in me through their word."

Jesus blessed the disciples and us. He gave us His Word to share with others.

What blocks you from taking advantage of opportunities to continue to grow in appreciation and knowledge of the Gospel message? Share a time that you felt affirmed in being sent forth.

Jesus Heals the Paralytic – Mark 2:3-5

"They came bringing a paralytic carried by four men...they opened up the roof...let down the mat on which the paralytic was lying. When Jesus saw their faith, He said, "Child, your sins are forgiven."

Jesus blesses our faith and helps others. Are there times when <u>your</u> faith or that of a group brought healing to others? Name some ways that unconditional love can bring light to darkness.

The Wedding Feast – John 2:3-5

"When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to Him, 'They have no wine.' Jesus said to her, 'Woman, how does your concern affect me?'...His mother said to the waiters, 'Do whatever He tells you."

Often we cannot provide the necessary assistance to another by ourselves. It is necessary to reach out to others.

What were some circumstances in your life that it was necessary to reach out to others for the assistance you were unable to give?

What role does faith and confidence play in these circumstances?

The Presence of Jesus - Matthew 18:20

"Jesus said to His disciples: 'For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them."

Jesus is never far from us when we gather as companions, either to strengthen our own relationship with Him, or to bring light to others.

Share a time when Jesus' Presence was felt profoundly as you gathered together. Identify the importance of faithfulness to prayer as we "join with others".

Attuning to the Spirit:

In what ways do these Scripture passages speak to your heart and spirit in ways to "join with others"?

Our Direction Statement helps us focus on Jesus' redeeming love. Joining with others makes our commitment to be the light that shines through the cracks of broken hearts a lived reality.

Our "joining" may not be physical but always our hearts are there. Perhaps our present situation is comfortable and safe but our sincere desire to join others can place us in their midst. Finding ourselves as one with others in God's beautiful world is blessing indeed. Together we form relationships whether tangible or in spirit.
